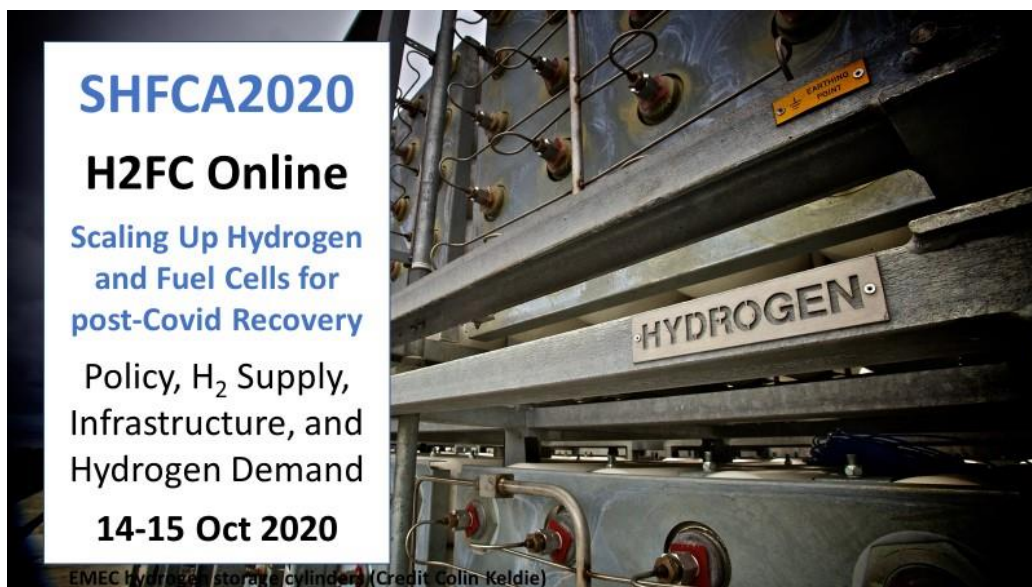
## SHFCA2020 H2FC ONLINE CONFERENCE PROGRAMME

SHFCA2020 H2FC Online takes place in two parts on the afternoon of Wednesday 14 October and the morning of Thursday 15 October 2020. This is our 12th SHFCA annual conference, which this year focuses on the green post-Covid recovery with hydrogen and fuel cells. SHFCA2020 H2FC Online addresses policy, hydrogen supply, infrastructure, and hydrogen demand. This brings together the key elements required to build a working hydrogen economy that will enable the transition to a low carbon energy system.

This year's annual conference will take place on-line for the first time ever, which offers the opportunity to widen our reach and significantly increase participation with hydrogen and fuel cell initiatives and activities in Scotland.

## SHFCA2020 H2FC ONLINE PROGRAMME. 14 OCTOBER 2020

SHFCA2020 Part 1 on **Wednesday 14 October** from **13:30 – 17:00 BST**

SHFCA2020 HFC Online Part 1 comprises of two consecutive sessions on the theme of building a hydrogen economy for Scotland. This will outline the policy frameworks needed to support a growing hydrogen economy, and building a new supply chain to scale up clean hydrogen production capacity in Scotland:

**Opening Plenary 13:30 – 15:00 BST.** This plenary session will highlight policy leadership and ambitions for hydrogen and fuel cells, with the speakers exploring the importance of cross-sector and international partnership working in the lead up to COP26.

This session is chaired by **Bruce Farquhar** of Anderson Strathern, with three speakers:

**Hydrogen Supply 15:30 – 17:00 BST.** This session on hydrogen supply will address the importance of the hydrogen supply chain, with updates on key projects for production of green and blue hydrogen.

This session is chaired by **Dave Holman** of Scottish Enterprise, with three speakers:

SHFCA2020 Part 2 on Thursday 15 October from 09:30 – 13:00 BST

SHFCA2020 H2FC Online Part 2 continues with two sessions which develop the core SHFCA2020 theme of building a hydrogen economy as part of the post-Covid recovery for Scotland.

**Hydrogen Infrastructure 09:30 – 11:00 BST.** This session explores building hydrogen infrastructure to connect the sources of hydrogen supply with the growing hydrogen demand.

**Hydrogen Demand 11:30 – 13:00 BST.** The final session of SHFCA2020 will address hydrogen demand, and how to build up this demand at sufficient scale and with attractive business models.

This panel discussion on hydrogen demand will conclude with the inaugural presentation of the **Stewart Dow Award**. This award will be made to an individual or group who has either developed practical solutions or an innovative product, has been successful in commercialising fuel cells in new applications, or has brought people together in a collaborative way.

The four sessions of SHFCA2020 H2FC Online will provide up to the minute insights on policy, hydrogen supply, infrastructure, and hydrogen demand. These are the four elements required to build a working hydrogen economy that will enable the transition to a low carbon energy system.

Hydrogen is evolving rapidly in Scotland. Join us at SHFCA2020 to identify the opportunities, and participate in the development and deployment of hydrogen and fuel cells across Scotland.
